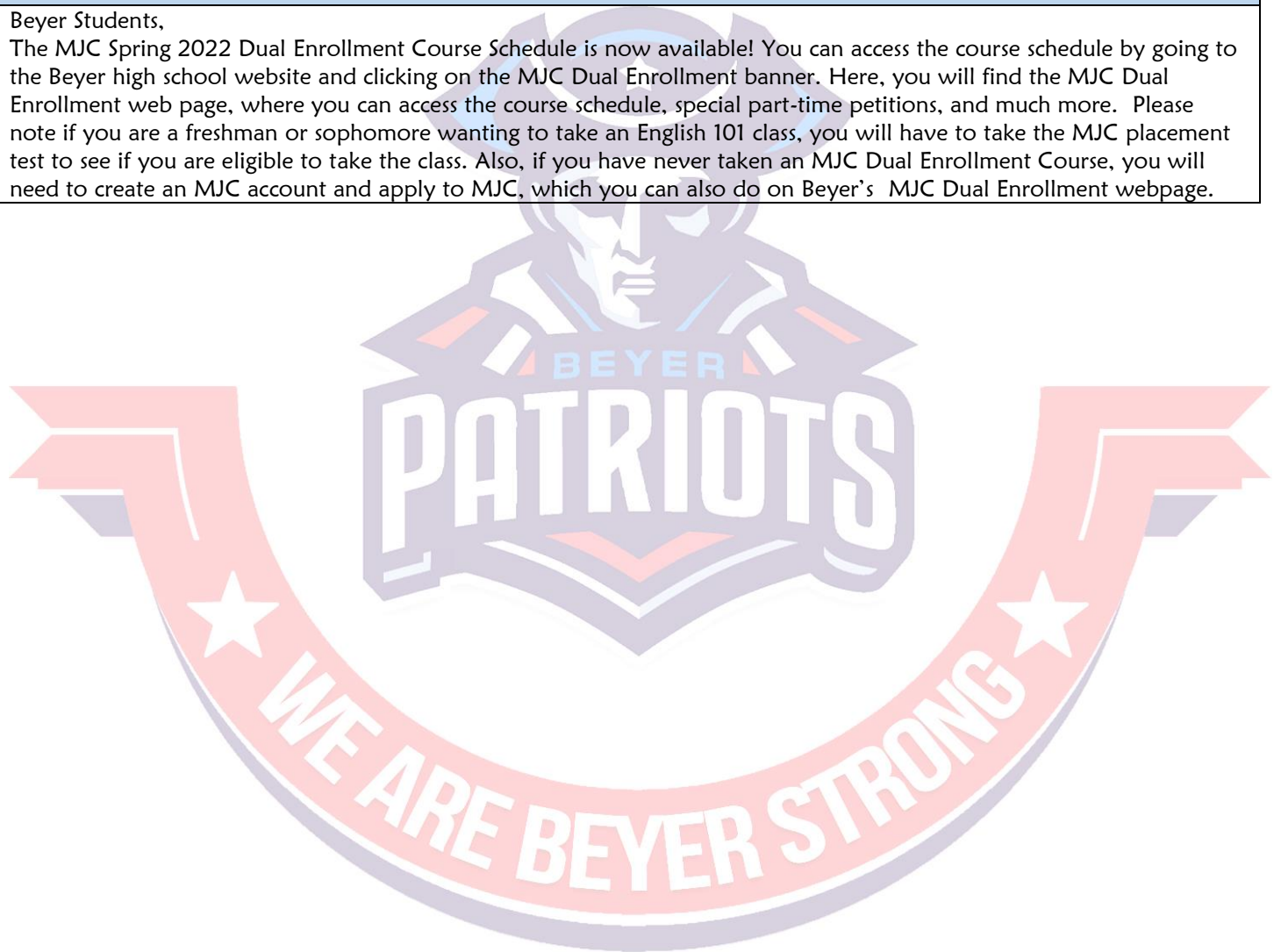
MJC WORKSHOP
