CSF Seniors If you are in need of your 4th or 6th semester of CSF, please pick up the clearance form from Barbara Nordman in the main office starting on May 16th. The form deadline is May 21st. Failure to turn in by the 21st may result in not earning CSF or CSF Highest Honor.

Seniors: For students who completed a FAFSA: A confirmation letter or email verifying that you completed your FAFSA is **not** a Cal Grant Award. As previously indicated, you must set up a web portal at www.webgrants4students.org to find out if you received at a CAL Grant or Middle Class Scholarship and then you must claim it. If you are having difficulty, you may contact the FAFSA Support number at 1-800-433-3243. You may also go to the following website studentsupport@csac.ca.gov and finally you may go to YouTube and search for How to Claim Your Cal Grant to view a great video and other valuable information regarding the FAFSA and financial aid. Ms. Gates provided you with a document containing all of the resources mentioned when she visited the government classes to help you complete the FAFSA. It is also posted on the Beyer website under **College Counseling Information** with the title **Financial Aid 2018**.

Seniors: College bound seniors: If you did not indicate the name of the college where you want your final transcript sent, on your mandatory senior survey, see Ms. Gates immediately. All transcript requests are taken from the survey. There is no need to request another transcript from our registrar, Mrs. Kauffman.
